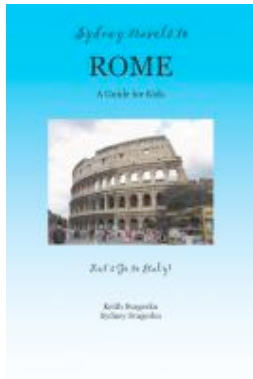

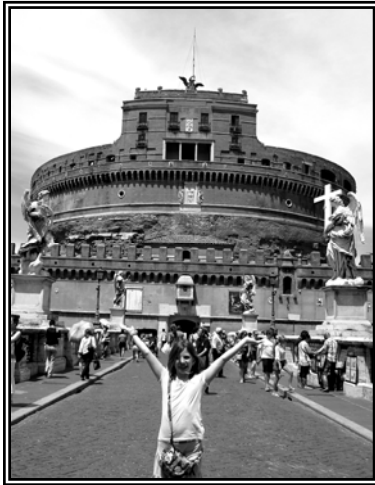

A Note from Keith



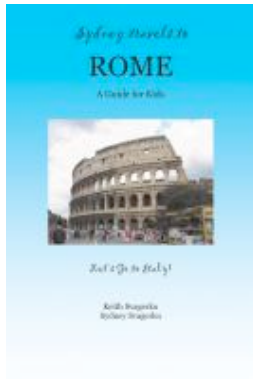
