One day Jack, the Amberjack fish, woke up in his house.

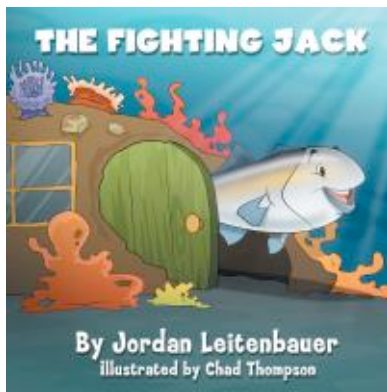
He looked out his front door and saw a large school of fish swim by.
