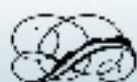

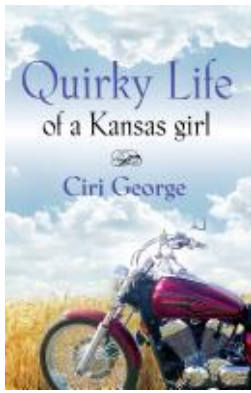

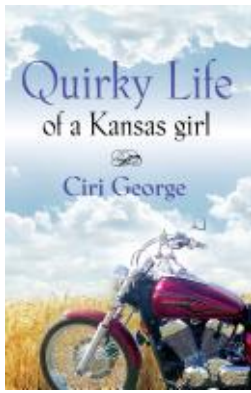
## **The Alley Incident**
