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Introduction

In My Life

In my current life I have had some times of great trial and tribulation and always held myself together even when it was very challenging. This is similar to my life as David where I had to overcome overwhelming odds. I refer to David in both the first and third person, partially due to being the same soul but also recognizing that was a different life and time.

Throughout my life, I learned to do the right thing and was honest to a fault without having to be told what to do. I was never interested in small talk nor did I have any interest to pretend to be someone I was not. I did this based upon instinct and intuition. I struggled to believe in anything supernatural and was overall disgusted by what I saw being done in the name of a divine being. I could not bring myself to believe because I could not believe what I was seeing. A man of "universal love" was the basis for doctrines of discrimination. While Christ taught compassion, it seemed the most religious people I was exposed to were the least compassionate. It seemed to be a contest of who could "out-Jesus" the other.

I find myself in a similar situation. As the story is told in scripture, David is chosen while watching a few sheep. He wasn't pursuing becoming a prophet or king, he was just doing what needed to be done. I've always had this approach in my current life. Just do what needs to be done, don't worry about whose "job" it is. David was perfectly happy to do his duty watching sheep. In my current life, I have always had strong drive and work ethic, even at times to the point of self-sacrifice. When I was called upon I was just working an hourly accounting job. Religion is often used to justify a special set of rules for certain groups, which is contrary to the teachings of the prophets. The overarching message of the prophets helps further our universal divine purpose.

God's agenda is universal love, universal charity, universal empathy, and making the world a better place. It's not an agenda about sectioning off people into particular groups and marginalizing them. Believe it or not, that same archdiocese who I contacted when all this first began, would later make the news for denouncing the movie "50 Shades of Grey" while putting lesser emphasis on the fact that the world was increasingly erupting into more chaos and suffering. It was like saying "The house is on fire! Quick! Someone do the dishes!"

Throughout the church age, power has been centralized through the suppression and perversion of information. It's time to give the power to the people and all give them access to a decent life and the pursuit of understanding. Knowledge should flow freely like water.

The Bible is not a book; it is a collection of books. The authors of the individual Gospel were not writing to be part of a bigger book, they were writing their own gospels in the context of the world in which they were called upon to teach. During my current life, I have witnessed the Bible being used to justify all sides of every issue. There is no spiritual value in memorizing a bunch of scripture, the spiritual value is understanding why the scripture reads as it does.

To Believe or Not to Believe

Over the years, I've never really believed in any particular religion and always struggled with an understanding of God. It seemed like every time I would try to find my way, there was always

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someone eager to point their finger at me and tell me I was doing it wrong.

I'd occasionally go to a church and sit in the pew wondering what any of it had to do with spirituality. We say the same things over and over, the doctrines, in many cases, were illogical; while one section was claiming we should not worship idols, the other seemingly wanted us idolizing Jesus Christ. It seemed like more of a social club than a holy place. I never fit in and felt like it was a waste of time.

I became challenged in this life as an atheist. In hindsight, I felt I'd made the right decisions without having to be dictated by some clergy. I would eventually see that God was testing me on my own merits before he called on me to do what he needed me to do.

The Journey Begins

Coming to acceptance was the first part of my journey, and took some time. At first, it seemed simple. I just kept a journal of what I was going through. Whenever I'd have a thought to explore, I'd notate it. It was similar to my days as a comic, keeping a pen and paper with me at all times trying to figure out what was funny. Only this time the subject matter was just a little more intense.

It wasn't until early 2014 that I started actually studying scripture. As a revenue auditor at a casino, I often found myself with down time as I waited for the count team to finish counting the money before I could begin balancing the revenues. I honestly think casinos should be called a "Shrine of Vice", because any destructive behavior is available in, or around, their vicinity. Despite the best attempts to be an "honest" business, they still take peoples' money and offer nothing but false hope in return. Come to think of it, they're like a corrupt church. Then again, at least the casino pays taxes.

In mid-2014 I became overwhelmed with the nature of the world events I was watching unfold. Knowing somehow that I would

eventually be part of them, was too hard for me to fathom, so I started spending a lot of time at the local casinos (as a patron, not an employee). I was trying to distract myself.

I fell into many old bad habits. But as I did, I eventually hit a moment when I was sick and tired of trying to run and decided to hit things head on. I went full throttle getting this information and experiences onto paper, and so this book began.

The bulk of the work was done in 2015. Toward the end of that year, I began a process of purging all my darkness. I had originally thought I would already be in the process of publishing, but divine timing had other plans. Many of the issues which arose during my awakening started to resolve as I stepped into my office to perform my duties. It was also a privilege to see God at work as I transitioned into my calling and going public.

This book has been designed in a way that offers common understanding of our interactions with our creator and the world we live in. The intent is to supplement and build upon previous knowledge, and give clarification where necessary.

Although this text can serve as a guide, we must put the principles into practice for it to have its full effect. However, realize that no amount of scripture can replace a true desire to know, and have a relationship with, the divine. As a science textbook gives us knowledge of science, it is by going into the world putting our knowledge into practice to better interact with our world that it becomes useful. The same principles apply here.

All celestial servants aid the same general purposes, but the ultimate purpose is truth. The truth remains constant. Regardless of how many ways men will try to hide or pervert it, eventually the truth will come to light. How knowledge is used is an important factor. The knowledge itself is neither good nor bad, but how it's being used that matters. Nuclear technology can be used to power homes or drop bombs. We can use the technology how we see fit, but we also have the choice of whether or not to build the bomb in the first place.

Leading Up to My Awakening

I've had health issues my whole life, and around Christmas of 2012, I got sick. I had an infection and went to the doctor. They weighed me in at 297 pounds. Over the course of the next few months, I would work to radically change my life. I had gone from fast food to a plant-based diet and was exercising regularly. In the process, I was just about to break the 240 pound mark, which is a weight I hadn't seen since just after graduating high school.

I never believed in anything supernatural before, but as the weight dropped I started to feel more peaceful and was opening myself up spiritually. I wasn't sure where I was at, but after living the life of an atheist turned agnostic, then believing there was another world, I was not sure where I was heading. I had no clue as to the ultimate plan of where I would be.

My wife and I had been looking forward to a trip to the Black Hills for years. We had three weeks off of work, we had both lost significant weight, and were loving life. After years of this trip being postponed, we finally made it to Deadwood. We had a great time and vowed to come back in the future.

While we were in Deadwood though, we experienced some paranormal activity at The Bullock Hotel. I even received my first electronic voice phenomenon (EVP^1) . I was barely aware of any kind of medium capability at that time. I could sense the presence of spirit but not receive messages.

We had stayed at a Bed and Breakfast. The host recommended visiting the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation to see the Red Cloud Indian School on our way out of town. We decided to go there. In the museum section there was a room dedicated to the massacre at Wounded Knee. When I was in that room, I felt a distinct heaviness attached to the battle and felt a spirit present. The entity had a heavy feeling to it. I now believe it was also my soul connecting to Wounded Knee and my previous life in that area, but I wasn't unaware of it at the time.
