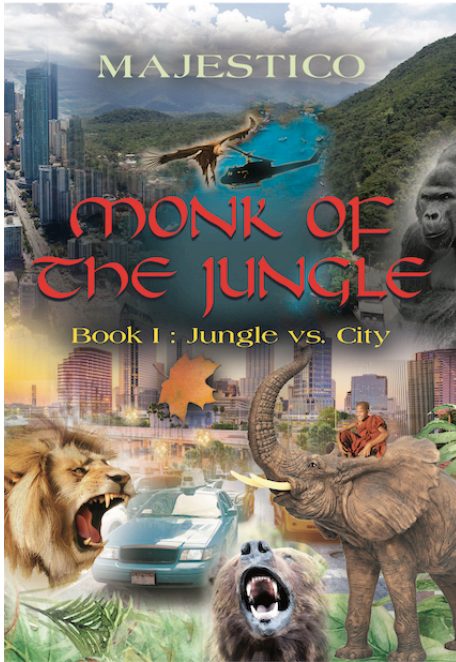
1.4 Magical & Mystical Jungle
