Buchanan and Anti-War

The Anti-War movement. Lew Rockwell published an article by Laurence Vance in March 2012. In it, he wrote “Stupid rules, stupid Republicans.” The article states that it’s not just the liberals who are against Pat Buchanan when it comes to the issue of foreign policy. The conservatives are against him as well, with the exception of Ron Paul, the former Presidential candidate.

Publications like National Review, The Weekly Standard, and conservative think tanks are against him. Conservative organizations like the Heritage Foundation and conservative talk show hosts (so-called conservative) like Levin, Hannity, O’Reilly and Limbaugh (take your pick). Republicans in the house are against him. Republicans in the senate are against him. Pat Buchanan has been a conservative fixture in politics in the media for decades.

In his 2011 book, *Suicide of a Superpower: Will America survive to 2025?*, there is much in it that conservatives will agree with, but also has some gems in

it that are an anathema to most conservatives and music to the ears of libertarians. Back in 1991 when George H. W. Bush invaded Iraq the first time, Buchanan was the sane and consistent voice for non-intervention. In the last 2 chapters of his book, Buchanan is at his best. He writes that as of 2011, the war in Afghanistan had cost us 6000 dead, 40,000 wounded, and over 1 trillion dollars. These wars destroyed the post 9/11 national unity, alienated the Islamic world, and enlarged the pool in which al-Qaida could fish in. These wars have bled us for over a decade and done less to make us safe than to inflame the Islamic world around us. Buchanan understands exactly why the U.S is hated by many in the Muslim world. We came to Afghanistan as liberators, but are seen now as occupiers with our ideas, values and heavy tyrants. After 8 years of war in Iraq and 18 in Afghanistan, we are coming home with Iraq going its own way and Afghan tipping towards the Taliban.

We fail to understand what motivates our attackers. They didn't come to kill us because they abhor our Constitution or want to impose sharia law in Oklahoma. They came to kill us in our country because we are over in their country. They came here because we will not leave there. Osama bin laden ordered 9/11 because U.S. Troops were on sacred Saudi land, the home of mecca.

But, not only must the U.S. bring an end to these wars, once these troops come home, the U.S. bases in Central Asia should be closed. The empire must be ended. This worldwide archipelago of bases may have been justified when we confronted a communist block spanning Eurasia, armed with thousands of nuclear weapons and driven by imperial ambition and ideological animus against the U.S., but the Cold War is history. It's absurd to contend that the 1000 overseas bases are vital to the U.S. security. Indeed, it is our pervasive military presence abroad, and our endless intervention and wars, which have made America, once the most admired of nations, among the world's most resented and detested. Why are scores of thousands of U.S. troops stationed in Europe when the evil empire collapsed 20 years ago? Why can't Europe defend itself against Russia, whose armies are but a fraction of the red army of 1990 and whose

western border is 100 miles east of where it was under Nicholas II.

The U.S. should declare its intent to withdraw from NATO, transfer the alliance to the Europeans and begin to vacate air and naval bases. Think of all the money that this would save us. The U.S. should also renegotiate the security treaties with S. Korea and Japan and remove U.S. ground troops from both countries. We are not going to fight another land war between Korea and China. No vital interests can justify such a war and the American people would not support sending an army to Korea like the 230,000 soldiers we sent in the 50's. The empire should have been dismantled after the Cold War. Now it is being forced upon us by a deficit debt crisis that the cost of that empire helped to produce. We cannot continue to kick the can up the road, for we have come to the end of the road. As Russia has gone home, some have urged that America should come home, leave NATO and all of the U.S. bases in Europe to Europeans, and become again what former U.N. Ambassador Jean Kirkpatrick once said 'a normal country in a normal time.'

But instead, George W invaded Afghanistan, declared Iran, Iraq, and Korea an axis of evil after a

determination by the Project for a New American Century (PNAC) project in 1997. PNAC warned the world that we would maintain military supremacy in every rival region of the globe. Bush declared preventive war and used it to invade and occupy Iraq, who never threatened or attacked us, and launched a global crusade of democracy that featured demonstrations to overthrow governments, install pro-American regimes in Serbia, Ukraine, Georgia, Kurdistan and Lebanon, as Eisenhower and the CIA did to Iran in 1953. Clinton and Bush II pushed NATO right up to Russia's front porch bringing 6 former Warsaw pact nations, East Germany, Hungary, Poland, the Czech Republic, Bulgaria, and Romania, and 3 Baltic States that had been part of the Soviet Union into an alliance to contain Russia. Only European resistance stopped Bush II from putting Ukraine and Georgia into a NATO fast-track membership which would, if there had been a Moscow/Tbilisi clash, put America into an eyeball to eyeball situation with a nation possessing thousands of nuclear weapons and it looks like that is what we are on the way to today. Obama doubled U.S Forces in Afghanistan, began drone strikes in Pakistan and launched a war in Libya. And Buchanan then asks what all of this compulsive intervention has availed us? And then answers: "We are less secure, less respected, less

confident, and less powerful that we were in 1991.” And, then, he asks “and is this world a better place?” The answer of course is a resounding no, and recognizing the disastrous consequences of the Iraq and Afghanistan wars, Buchanan sees no point in threatening Iran over its nonexistent nuclear weapons program. The immediate goal must be to derail the war party’s campaign to have America launch a preemptive strike on Iran’s nuclear facility, as that would trigger acts of terrorism against U.S. soldiers and civilians from Baghdad to Beirut. An early result of such a war could be the closing of the Persian Gulf, crippling the U.S. and world economy.

If America could deter the Russia of Stalin and the China of Mao, who declared themselves willing to leave 300 million Chinese, why can’t we deter an Iran that has no bomb or missiles to deliver? In contrast to the sane policy ideas of Buchanan, all we hear is a call for more war and more bloodshed.

Conservative warmongers and Republican war party members don’t want to listen to non-intervention, but they will have to deal with their elder statesman Pat Buchanan, and I think that they will have their hands full. Well, let’s hope so, because I think that people are

Senator Joseph McCarthy

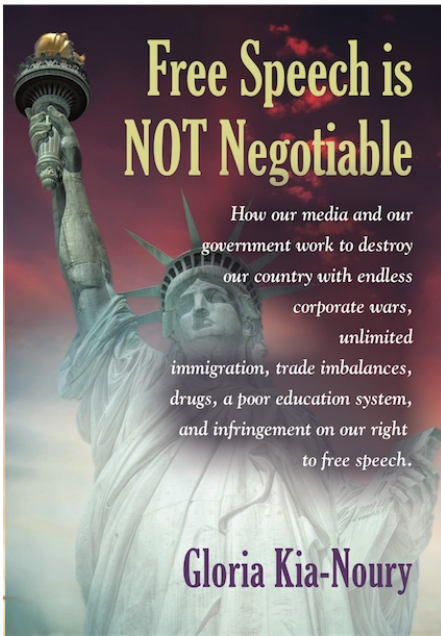
