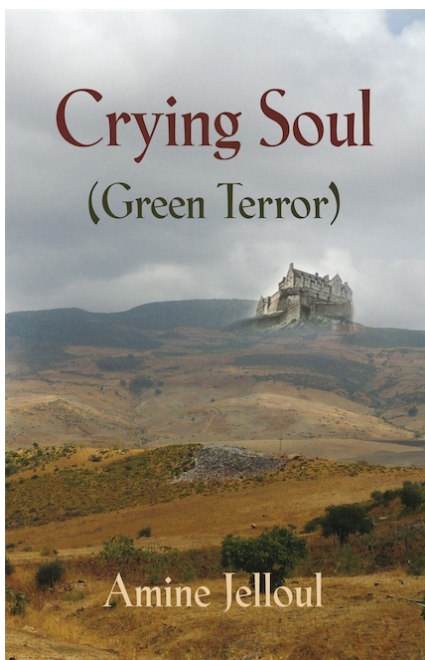
A man runs away from his native nest hoping to save his “crying soul” until he suddenly collides with a “bitter truth.”
