Self: There were times in my thirties when my checking account was zero; my emergency account was zero. I had to (and still do) choose to believe that God would provide. In times of nothingness, sometimes I go through an exercise in my mind that reviews how God has worked in my lineage. My great grandparents had to leave everything in the 1920's in the south to start over with nothing and my single grandparent left an inheritance to my generation. I recall a season of our whole household being jobless and watching as God provided for our needs and desires. God is faithful.


Encouragement: Continue to give and serve Him who is able and will be faithful to His promise and character to be Jehovah Jireh - a great provider.
