Introduction

al·le·go·ry / 'alə gôrē/

Noun - "A story, poem, or picture that can be interpreted to reveal a hidden meaning, typically a moral or political one." – *Oxford English Dictionary*.

A synonym of allegory is a tale, which is described as a fictitious or true narrative or story, especially one that is imaginatively recounted.

So is an allegory really about what's inherently in a text we read, a movie we watch, or a painting we look at? Or is it more about how we engage with a text, a movie, a piece of art, or a story repeated over and over?

It has amazed me how the word allegory almost sounds like Al Gore. Do his actions fit the meaning? When you think of his arrogance over the years, you must agree it certainly appears that way.

I grew up in New York. I remember, as a child, winters where there were many days, even weeks, when we played outside without a jacket or sweater. I remember summer days when I needed a jacket to keep the cool breezes from chilling my body. Even today, the seasons have

been erratic in their character, which can sometimes redefine logic. After all, the winters are supposed to be cold, and the summers warm. With that in mind, I wondered what caused all these changes. After all, as I said, living in New York, it would be nice if I never had to pick up another snow shovel.

What needs to be considered is the difference between climate and weather. Weather is the state of the environment at a given place and time as regards heat, dryness, sunshine, wind, rain, snow, etc. An example of weather would be a forecast that it is expected to rain in a particular part of a country where it usually doesn't rain.

Climate is the weather conditions prevailing in a defined area over the long term; for example, the climate in Florida is usually hot and humid, even during the winter months.

I started to research climate changes in the world as far back as I could. The things that I discovered were amazing. The one thing that I found most revealing is this.

The Earth is not a static place. Neither are the other planets in our solar system; we have found that fact through space exploration. We live on the crust of a ball of hot magma spinning at over seventeen thousand miles per hour, traveling around the Sun at about the same

speed. Earth is a dynamic, active globe, and to expect it will never change is baffling. Over the past millions of years, the Earth has proven to have gone through drastic changes both in climate and geological terms. This physical planet is a gift to those who inhabit it; we need to be prepared, not if but when changes occur. We must learn to live with these changes, not try to alter the will of God and Mother Nature.

What follows is the real science behind Global Climate Change, not the consensus scientist's pretentiousness, who operates with no empirical testing, and the believers of the myth that "the planet Earth world will be uninhabitable in ten years unless we get to zero carbon emissions." The former United States Vice President (Al Gore) said that over forty years ago.

I am not a climate change denier. Weather patterns change continually. Temperatures will always go up and down. Snow and rain will continue to fall, sometimes creating new records. Winds will continue to blow; hurricanes will continue to occur as well as tornados, earthquakes, volcanic eruptions, and all the other natural disasters that have taken place over the past millions of years. And yes, glaciers will continue to expand and contract over long periods as they always have.

As you read this book, I only ask one thing of you, look at the scientific data and principles I present. I will not ask you to change your

mind about climate change. I want you to have an open mind. I will only submit the facts to you, showing you that spending hundreds of billions of dollars as we have in the past and most people in power still want to spend will do nothing to change the climate.

It is no different from the three trillion dollars the United States has spent since 1966 under President Lyndon Johnson's "Great Society Program" to cure poverty — *nothing has changed*. If the world gets to zero carbon dioxide emissions, nothing will change, except that plants will not be able to produce oxygen because CO2 is the nourishment they need. What will the world look like without oxygen? We only have to look at Mars, where life may have existed millions of years ago.

A theory is conjecture; a synonym for conjecture is guesswork. It is a hypothesis that has not been proven. Science is factual. Facts are absolute. You cannot change absolute. The fact that the Sun will rise and set each day, the mathematical fact that two plus two will always equal four, or that gravity will keep my feet on the ground are absolutes. No one can argue with those facts.

On the other hand, the theory of Global Warming may be the biggest scam in the world's history. According to Al Gore, "The Science is settled," but that's what he wants you to believe. I will present real science and facts sprinkled with common sense views that

should make you stop and think why anyone didn't explain it to me that way before.

In doing my research, I found it easier than I thought. I didn't have to go to the library. I didn't have to travel around the world to interview numerous scientists. I never left my computer. My mining into the past for data was done because of the man who claims he invented the internet. *[Thanks, Al]* The same man who said, "If you listen to me, we can stop the planet from destroying itself." It's not destroying itself, it's changing, as it always has, and we must learn to live with those changes.

Facts are based on information that does not contain emotion. An opinion is based upon information that includes our experiences. Ignorance is an opinion that lacks knowledge, and stupidity is an opinion that ignores the facts.

During my tenure as a detective in New York City, the largest police department in the United States, I have learned never to take anything at face value. I never looked at a forest and only examined the trees. I dug down to the roots to see what strength lies beneath. It is no different in life than what I investigated, what we hear on the news, and the theories people expound on mostly are conjecture. As I learned during my career, I searched for the truth in whatever I saw or heard. I

followed the pragmatic evidence wherever it took me. I learned to live with the facts no matter what they were. Because I never wanted to put an innocent person in prison.

So, when I heard all the rhetoric about global warming, I was perplexed because I listened to and read so many stories that didn't make sense to me. Things that took scientific doctrines and principles and tore them apart. Things that we are being told that defy logic.

In the following pages, I will present the facts and scientific principles that will lead you to realize that the theory of global warming, which states that human behavior is the leading cause, is conjecture. It is a scam that has cost nations and corporations worldwide hundreds of billions of dollars. It has lined the pockets of politicians and other green energy entrepreneurs with millions of dollars and, in some cases, billions.

As you read through these pages, you may find some of the information is technical. I have tried to simplify the science so that it can easily be understood. However, science is technical because it is based on experimentation, whereas consensus is not.

This book will present to you the scientific facts about climate change. Science is absolute; you cannot change science; it is principled.

Consensus is an opinion, an unproven belief with no basis of fact; it continuously changes.

Psychologists use the term "Gaslighting" to refer to a specific type of manipulation where the manipulator is trying to get someone else or a group of people to question their reality or perceptions. I will leave it for you to decide. But decide before the government takes all your rights and your money.

Should I ask Al Gore for his advice on love if this book was a romance novel? After all, he claims he and his ex-wife Tipper were "the subjects for Eric Segal's novel *Love Story*?"

Mr. Segal said he had been "befuddled" by the report published in *Time Magazine* and had called the Vice President to find out what had happened. Al Gore told Eric Segal that the whole thing was a misunderstanding. Is that what Gore will say to us in the future, that Global Warming was only a misunderstanding?

Is There A Doctor In the House?

n an interview some years ago, Al Gore stated, "If you don't believe in Global Warming, read Michael Crichton's book, *State of Fear.*" Did the former Vice President forget Dr. Crichton's book was fiction?

In 2005, President George W. Bush met for about an hour in the oval office of the White House with author Dr. Michael Crichton, whose best-selling novel "*State of Fear*" had been published in 2004 and reached the New York Times bestseller list in January 2005. The President and Dr. Crichton met for over one hour to discuss the subject matter of State of Fear; namely, a plot by environmentalists to deliberately engineer (un)natural catastrophes in an attempt to garner public support for climate change initiatives. President Bush, who had originally campaigned in 2000 as the "environmental candidate," seized on the opportunity presented by this popular work of fiction to cast off the last vestiges of any legitimate concern for the environment.

President Bush had never met for one minute, let alone one hour, with any climate scientist or environmentalist to discuss climate change. The outcome of the meeting with Michael Crichton was official stagnation in the response of the United States to climate change - an outcome which has more-or-less persisted a decade later in 2014, even though the party of the administration has changed hands.

"State of Fear" is a novel that tells the story of a group of crazed, power and money-hungry environmental activists who conspire to disrupt weather, generate tsunamis, and, in general, wreak havoc at specific times and places to stir public opinion in favor of those who expound upon the catastrophic consequences of climate change. For the most part, the book follows the typical Crichton formula upon which some of his other works (The Andromeda Strain, Jurassic Park, etc.) were based, namely, a small group of heroes and heroines fighting bravely to expose the nefarious dealings of well-organized and powerful (and preferably government-based) groups who aim to harm innocent people.

As with his other works, "*State of Fear*" is chuck full of science tidbits meant to impress the reader with the depth and breadth of Mr. Crichton's (Harvard MD but never practiced medicine) knowledge. "*State of Fear*" differs from other science fantasy works in that it is replete with footnotes and a bibliography. The inescapable impression

to be garnered by the reader is that, although this is a work of fiction, it is to be taken seriously - seriously enough to impress the President of the United States.

Unfortunately for Mr. Crichton, "State of Fear" is not about to impress many in the geoscience community. The work is a merger of denialist, anti-climate change arguments taken almost verbatim from the works of Bjorn Lomborg with action-sex-packed, cliff-hanging, chase-and-shoot-em-up scenes clearly meant to impress producers of adolescent conspiracy movies (ala Steven Spielberg) and result in yet another cinematic blockbuster for the late Mr. Crichton. Somewhere, there is a story about why Hollywood didn't pick it up. (Maybe it didn't fit the Global Warming narrative?)

It may be seen as improper to review "*State of Fear*" on the same plane as other serious works of non-fiction on climate change. After all, it is just a work of fiction - "It wasn't meant to be taken seriously." But it was - and the consequences may prove much more serious than Dr. Crichton could have ever dreamed."¹

Al Gore apparently took the story seriously enough to put on his superman costume and try to save the world from an imaginary foe. Like a kid with his wooden sword running through a playground trying to beat back all his imaginary enemies.

However, Gore's pronouncements are based on consensus and conjecture, not empirical science. Had he studied natural science and not science fiction, maybe we wouldn't be in today's green energy predicament. A movement based on supposition and false narratives that is costing countries hundreds of billions of dollars for programs that in no way, according to empirical science, can change the climate. He has gaslighted the leaders of the free world, with the help of the Norwegian Nobel Committee, into believing that within ten years, life on this planet, which we cherish so much, will be destroyed beyond repair. It is all based on conjecture. He said that in 1993 and continually repeated it, "ten years" for the next thirty years, nothing has changed.

During a presentation at a Caltech Lecture Series titled "Aliens Cause Global Warming,"

Dr. Michael Crichton stated the following:

"I want to talk about this notion of consensus and the rise of what has been called consensus science. I regard consensus science as an extremely pernicious development that ought to be stopped cold in its tracks. Historically, the claim of consensus has been the first refuge of scoundrels; it is a way to avoid debate by claiming that the matter is already settled. *[Sound familiar?]* Whenever you hear the consensus of

scientists agreeing on something or other, reach for your wallet because you're being had.

Let's be clear: the work of science has nothing to do with consensus. Consensus is the business of politics. On the contrary, science requires only one correct investigator, which means they have verifiable results.

In science, a consensus is irrelevant. What is relevant are reproducible results. The greatest scientists in history are great precisely because they broke with the consensus. There is no such thing as consensus science. If it's consensus, it isn't science. If it's science, it isn't consensus. Period.

In addition, let me remind you that the consensus's track record is nothing to be proud of. Let's review a few cases.

In past centuries, the greatest killer of women was fever following childbirth. One woman in six died of this fever.

In 1795, Alexander Gordon of Aberdeen suggested that the fevers were infectious processes, and he was able to cure them. The consensus said no.

In 1843, Oliver Wendell Holmes claimed puerperal fever was contagious and presented compelling evidence. The consensus said no.

In 1849, Semmel Weiss demonstrated that sanitary techniques virtually eliminated puerperal fever in hospitals under his management. The consensus said he was a Jew, ignored him, and dismissed him from his post. There was, in fact, no agreement on puerperal fever until the start of the twentieth century. Thus, the consensus took one hundred and twenty-five years to arrive at the correct conclusion despite the efforts of the prominent "skeptics" around the world, skeptics who were demeaned and ignored, despite the constant ongoing deaths of women.

There is no shortage of other examples. In the 1920s in America, tens of thousands of people, mostly poor, were dying of a disease called pellagra. The consensus of scientists said it was infectious, and it was necessary to find the "pellagra germ." The U.S. government asked a brilliant young investigator, Dr. Joseph Goldberger, to find the cause. Goldberger concluded that diet was the crucial factor. The consensus remained wedded to the germ theory.

Goldberger demonstrated that he could induce the disease through diet. He demonstrated that the disease was not infectious by injecting a pellagra patient's blood into himself and his assistant. They and other volunteers swabbed their noses with swabs from pellagra patients and

swallowed capsules containing scabs from pellagra rashes in what were called "Goldberger's filth parties." Nobody contracted pellagra.

The consensus continued to disagree with him. There was, in addition, a social factor-southern States disliked the idea of poor diet as the cause because it meant that social reform was required. They continued to deny it until the 1920s. Despite a twentieth-century epidemic, the consensus took years to see the light.

Probably every schoolchild notices that South America and Africa seem to fit together rather snugly, and Alfred Wegener proposed, in 1912, that the continents had drifted apart. The consensus sneered at continental drift for fifty years. The great geology names most vigorously denied the theory until 1961, when it began to seem as if the sea floors were spreading. The result: it took the consensus fifty years to acknowledge what any schoolchild sees.

The examples can be multiplied endlessly. Jenner and smallpox, Pasteur, and germ theory. Saccharine, margarine, repressed memory, fiber and colon cancer, hormone replacement therapy. The list of consensus errors goes on and on. Finally, I would remind you to notice where the claim of consensus is invoked. Consensus is invoked only in situations where the science is not solid enough."² So, when Al Gore states, "the consensus of the scientists say that the human race is responsible for Global Warming. Should we believe him or the science? Not his science, the actual science, because his science is based on consensus, not experimentation.

Using the presidential debates between Vice President Al Gore and Texas Governor George W.
