1. The Arkvark! (OK, you know about aardvarks, a common stumbling block in spelling competitions.)

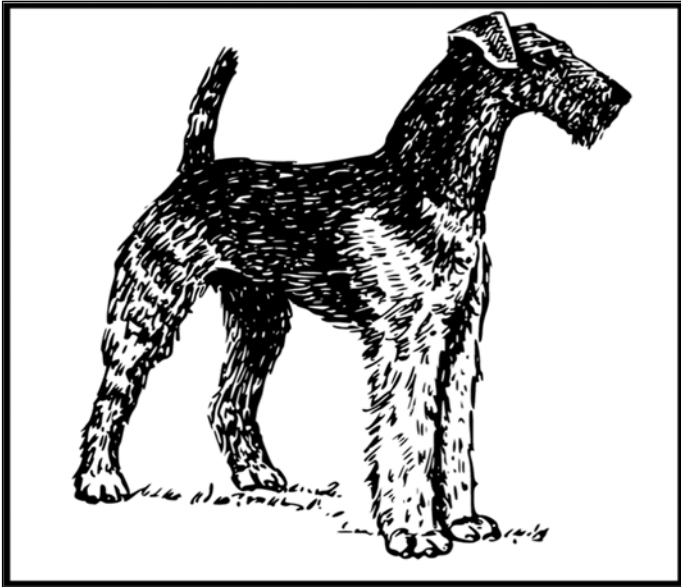
2. The Arktodo! (OK, obscure; a play on the name of the extinct Arctodus, a very large animal, somewhat akin to a grizzly bear.)

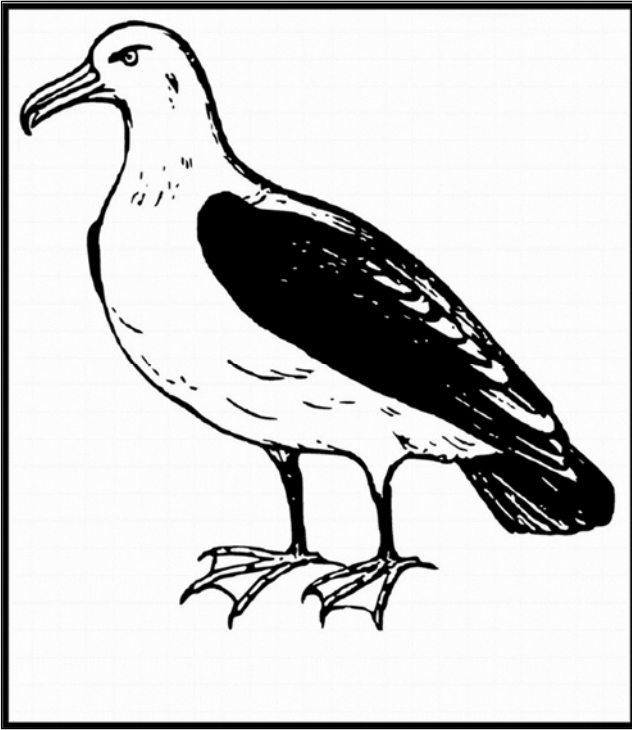
