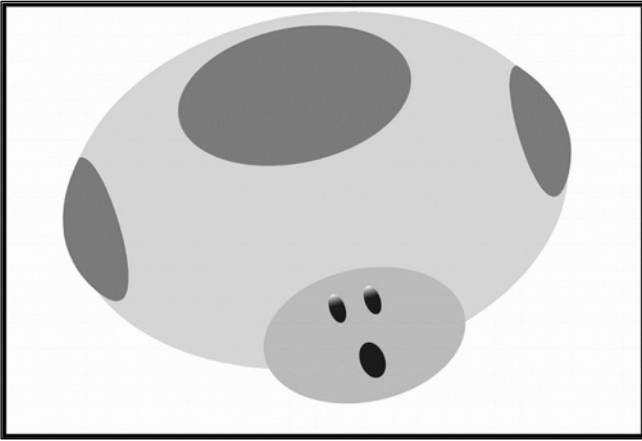
Fancy Food

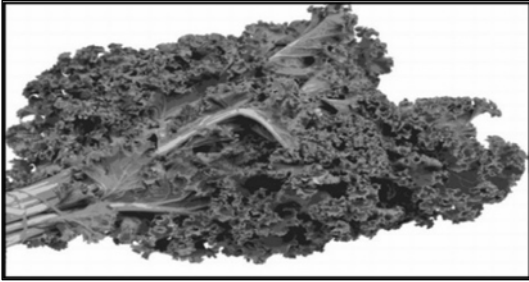

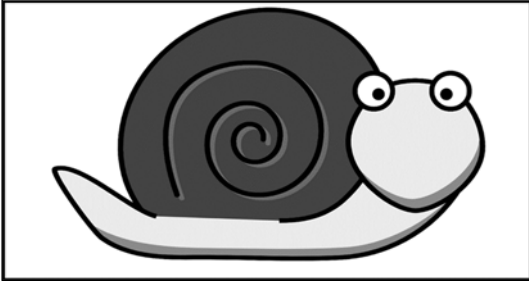

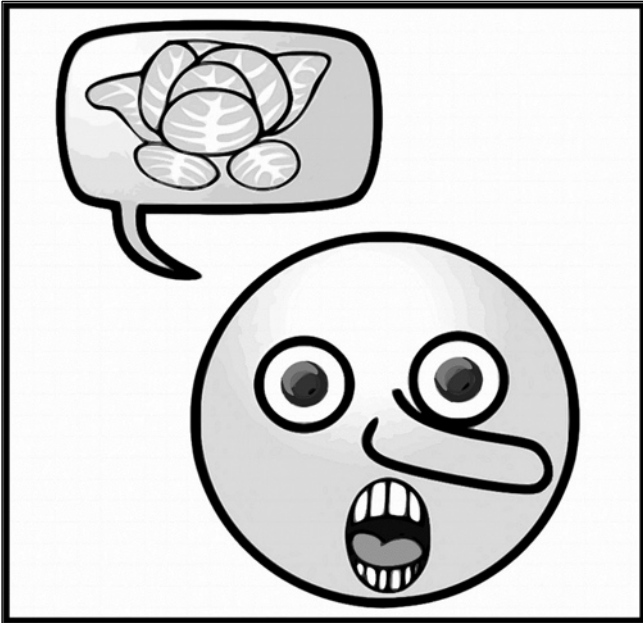

Let us repair to the world of meat. Carnivore-land, wherein we incur the contempt of vegetarians and vegans everywhere!

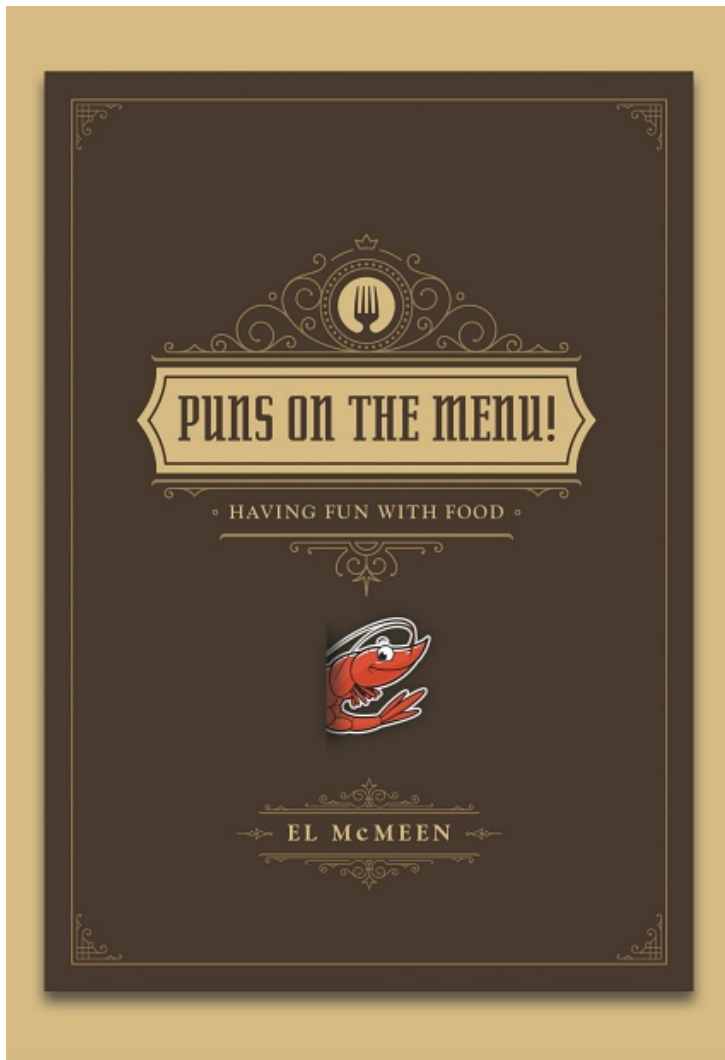
