




You have shown us that living symbiotically with nature on this planet is not only possible, but preferable – full of richness, freedom and quality time.


So the **dol**phins got **star**ted wearing **clothes** just for **fun**, trying to **look** like the **fish**ies colored **bright** as the **sun**!

From the Artist


