## Hello Ladies:

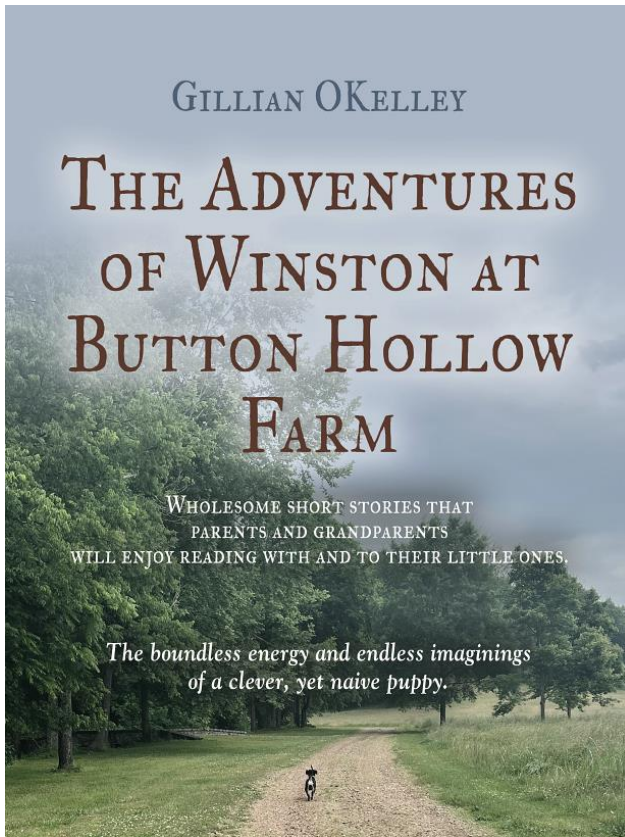
