Chapter 8: Rallies Set the Stage for Primary Election

The presidential primaries and caucuses of the Republican Party took place within all 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, and five U.S. territories between January 15, 2024, and June 4, 2024. These elections selected most of the 2,429 delegates to be sent to the Republican National Convention. Former president Donald Trump was thereby nominated for president of the United States for a third consecutive election cycle. Bravo!

Shortly after the rallies began in 2023, you may recall that a crowded field of candidates emerged, including Trump, Florida governor Ron DeSantis, former Ambassador to the United Nations Nikki Haley, and wealth management executive Vivek Ramaswamy. Trump maintained a consistent lead in primary polling from back in 2020 right after Biden supposedly beat him in the presidential election.

Among non-Trump candidates, DeSantis was at first a big threat. Initially, he was polling in a close second behind Trump, but his numbers steadily declined the longer the game was being played—all throughout 2023 and into 2024.

Ramaswamy came out of nowhere and experienced a small bump in his polling in mid-2023. However, this

uptick proved to be brief. Haley stayed in believing apparently that she could ultimately. Her campaign began attracting greater attention in the final months of 2023, though neither she nor any other candidate came close to Trump in polling. Trump seemed to be unbeatable. Because Trump looked like he could not be stopped, the Republican primaries were referred to as a "race for second" due to Trump's consistent lead in the polls.

When 2024 came, the weather in Iowa was freezing cold. BRRRRR!!! Nonetheless Trump's popularity caused Iowans to brave the frigid weather and come out to support Trump. At the January 15 Iowa caucuses, Trump posted a landslide victory.

DeSantis just about beat out Haley for second place and Ramaswamy finished in a distant fourth. Following Iowa, Ramaswamy and DeSantis read the tealeaves and all other sources of knowledge and both of them dropped out of the race and endorsed Trump. This left just Trump and Haley as the only remaining major candidates. But not for long!

Trump kept up the onslaught and eight days later defeated Haley in the January 23 New Hampshire primary, although it was a smaller margin of victory than he achieved in Iowa. He beat Haley again in the February 24 South Carolina primary just a month later.

Then, after Trump's overwhelming victories nationwide on Super Tuesday, Haley finally saw the light and on March 6, she suspended her campaign. She had won only Vermont and the District of Columbia. Her victory in the Washington, D.C. primary on March 3, 2024, made her the first woman ever to win a Republican Party presidential primary contest. But there were no cigars for a nice try.

Some Republicans expressed concerns about Trump because of a number of reasons. First of all, he had lost in 2020. Secondly, he was accused of inciting the January 6 Capitol attack. Thirdly the Democrats lawfare was producing ongoing criminal cases and indictments against him, and fourth, the results of the 2022 midterms were not solid. Several Trump-endorsed candidates lost key races. Many others supported him and publicly denounced the investigations as politically motivated, and Trump maintained high favorability ratings among Republican voters.

There seemed to be an all-out attack from multiple sources to get Trump at all costs. For example, Trump's eligibility to appear on the ballot was challenged by some voters and by political leaders in Colorado, Maine and Illinois.

Nonetheless a lot of what was being thrown at Trump was not sticking. These efforts were rejected by the Supreme Court of the United States in a unanimous decision. Trump became the presumptive nominee on

March 12, with his victory in the Washington State Presidential Primary bringing him over the 1,215 delegate threshold needed to clinch the nomination.

On July 15, 2024, Trump and his new running mate, U.S. Senator from Ohio JD Vance, were officially nominated as the Republican presidential and vice presidential candidates at the Republican National Convention.

The pair won the general election on November 5, defeating the Democratic Party ticket of incumbent Vice President Kamala Harris and her running mate, Minnesota governor Tim Walz.

During the summer of 2024 after the debate with Trump, Biden suffered a long summer of discontent as he fell from grace as rapid as lightening travels through the sky. After the debate with Trump in June 2024, Joe Biden faced a challenging period.

Biden's less than poor performance in the debate led to more and more concerns about his ability to serve a second term as president. All of a sudden even Democrats were questioning his stamina and cognitive health.

Biden's performance was widely criticized. It seemed he could not even speak coherently and he would repeatedly lose his train of thought/ This seemed to confirm Trump's assertions that Biden was too old and

far too frail to lead the country as president. Secretly Trump was pleased to have this Joe Biden as his opponent.

After the debate, Biden's campaign tried to reassure the public that his performance was not an age-related decline, but too many had seen the debate and they were not buying the excuses. Moreover, the replays of the debate proved devastating for Biden as more and more people knew there was some kind of cover-up of his cognitive difficulties. The damage was already done. Trump's debate performance basically had eliminated Biden as a viable candidate.

At the same time, Biden was under pressure from Democrat leaders to drop out. Eventually, he suspended his re-election campaign on July 21, 2024, and as a lemming endorsed Vice President Kamala Harris, marking a significant fall from grace for the incumbent president.

The debate put the Democratic Party in turmoil. It was initially divided in its response to Biden's debate performance. Some very prominent Democrats, including former Presidents Barack Obama and Bill Clinton, rallied behind the president him, while others called for him to step down.

However, as the summer wore on, it became increasingly clear that Biden's chances of winning re-election were

slipping away. The ultimate Democrat response was fait accompli.

Trump is now the president after battling lawfare and dirty tactics from Democrats throughout his campaign. He has been characterized by the left as the most polarizing figure in modern American politics. However, for now, he gets to “relax” and simply be the best leader the country has had since he was last president. Trump’s victory was historical among many other things. The last

A major metaphor for Trump's perseverance was his reaction to being shot at a rally in Butler, Pennsylvania, in July. A bullet hit his right ear and the Secret Service covered him to avoid problems with a potential second shot. Trump's response, bloodied ear and all, was to put his fist in the air and yell "Fight, Fight, Fight!" This sequence became part of his late-campaign ads as part of his closing argument.

Through a panoply of false and polarizing information and smears from his rivals, most notably Kamala Harris, Trump pointed out that the new politics and the lawfare in America were corrupt, and that the country under Kamala and Biden was economically failing and crime-ridden. Trump was seen by supporters as always telling the truth and Harris seemed to suffer the same aversion to the truth that Biden continually displayed.

Few realistic political observers expected Kamala Harris to beat Donald Trump. Yet, the way the Democrat-

loving press behaved, you would not conclude that. For most of Harris' relatively brief candidacy, she and Trump were painted as being locked in a very tight race. Consequently, Kamala Harris' unbelievably dismal showing was somewhat unexpected.

Fox News Voter Analysis hit the nail on the head with 63 percent of respondents saying the state of the economy is poor or not so good. Specifically a large percentage said the single most important factor was the high price of gas. The Biden economy of which Kamala

"... the golden age of America begins right now. From this day forward, our country will flourish and be respected again all over the world. We will be the envy of every nation, and we will not allow ourselves to be

taken advantage of any longer. During every single day of the Trump administration, I will very simply put America first.

“Our sovereignty will be reclaimed, our safety will be restored. Scales of justice will be rebalanced. The vicious, violent, and unfair weaponization of the Justice Department and our government will end.

“Our top priority will be to create a nation that is proud, prosperous and free. America will soon be greater, stronger, and far more exceptional than ever before.

“I return to the presidency confident and optimistic that we are at the start of a grilling, new era, of national success. A tide of change is sweeping the country. Sunlight is pouring over the entire world, and America has the chance to seize this opportunity like never before, but first, we must be honest about the challenges we face.

“While they are plentiful, they will be annihilated by this great momentum that the world is now witnessing in the United States of America. As we gather today, our government confronts a crisis of trust. For many years, a radical and corrupt establishment has extracted power and wealth from our citizens while the pillars of our society lay broken and seemingly in complete disrepair.

“We now have a government that cannot manage even a simple crisis at home, while at the same time stumbling into a continuing catalog of catastrophic events abroad.

It fails to protect our magnificent law abiding American citizens, but provide sanctuary and protection for dangerous criminals, many from prisons and mental institutions that have illegally entered our country from all over the world.

“We have a government that has given unlimited funding to the defense of foreign borders but refuses to defend American borders, or, more importantly, its own people.

“Our country can no longer deliver basic services in times of emergency, as recently shown by the wonderful people of North Carolina, who've been treated so badly. And other states who are still suffering from a hurricane that took place many months ago. Or more recently, Los Angeles, where we are watching fires still tragically burn from weeks ago without even a token of defense. They're raging through the houses and communities, even affecting some of the wealthiest and most powerful individuals in our country, some of whom are sitting here right now. They don't have a home any longer. That's interesting.

“But we can't let this happen. Everyone is unable to do anything about it. That's going to change. We have a public health system that does not deliver in times of disaster, yet more money is spent on it than any country anywhere in the world. And we have an education system that teaches our children to be ashamed of themselves, in many cases to hate our country despite

the love that we try so desperately to provide to them. All of this will change starting today and will change very quickly.

“Our recent election is a mandate to completely and totally reverse a horrible betrayal, and all of these many betrayals that have taken place, and to give the people back their faith, their wealth, their democracy and indeed their freedom. From this moment on, America's decline is over.

“Our liberties and our nation's glorious destiny will no longer be denied and we will immediately restore the integrity, competency and loyalty of America's government. Over the past eight years, I have been tested and challenged more than any president in our 250-year history, and I've learned a lot along the way. The journey to reclaim our Republic has not been an easy one, that I can tell you. Those who wish to stop our cause have tried to take my freedom and indeed to take my life. Just a few months ago, in a beautiful Pennsylvania field, an assassin's bullet ripped through my ear. But I felt then, and believe even more so now, that my life was saved for a reason. I was saved by God to make America great again.

“That is why each day under our administration of American patriots, we will be working to meet every crisis with dignity and power and strength. We will move with purpose and speed to bring back hope, prosperity, safety and peace for citizens of every race,

religion, color and creed. For American citizens, Jan. 20, 2025, is Liberation Day.

“It is my hope that our recent presidential election will be remembered as the greatest and most consequential election in the history of our country. As our victory showed, the entire nation is rapidly unifying behind our agenda with dramatic increases in support from virtually every element of our society. Young and old, men and women, African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Asian Americans, urban, suburban and rural. And, very importantly, we had a powerful win in all seven swing states and the popular vote. We won by millions of people.

“To the Black and Hispanic communities, I want to thank you for the tremendous outpouring of love and trust that you have shown me with your vote. We set records, and I will not forget it. I've heard your voices in the campaign, and I look forward to working with you in the years to come.

“Today is Martin Luther King Day and his honor — this will be a great honor — but in his honor, we will strive together to make his dream a reality. We will make his dream come true.

“National unity is now returning to America and confidence and pride is soaring like never before. In everything we do my administration will be inspired by a strong pursuit of excellence and unrelenting success. We

will not forget our country. We will not forget our Constitution. And we will not forget our God.

“Today, I will sign a series of historic executive orders. With these actions, we will begin the complete restoration of America and the revolution of common sense. It's all about common sense. First, I will declare a national emergency at our southern border. All illegal entry will immediately be halted. And we will begin the process of returning millions and millions of criminal aliens back to the places from which they came. We will reinstate my remain in Mexico policy. I will end the practice of catch and release. And I will send troops to the southern border to repel the disastrous invasion of our country. Under the orders I sign today we will also be designating the cartels as foreign terrorist organizations. And by invoking the Alien Enemies Act of 1798, I will direct our government to use the full and immense power of federal and state law enforcement to eliminate the presence of all foreign gangs and criminal networks bringing devastating crime to U.S. soil, including our cities and inner cities.

“As commander in chief, I have no higher responsibility than to defend our country from threats and invasions. And that is exactly what I am going to do. We will do it at a level that nobody has ever seen before. Next, I will direct all members of my cabinet to marshal the vast powers at their disposal to defeat what was record inflation and rapidly bring down costs and prices. The inflation crisis was caused by massive overspending and

escalating energy prices. And that is why today I will also declare a national energy emergency. We will drill, baby, drill.

“America will be a manufacturing nation once again, and we have something that no other manufacturing nation will ever have: the largest amount of oil and gas of any country on Earth. And we are going to use it. We will bring prices down, fill our strategic reserves up again, right to the top, and export American energy all over the world. We will be a rich nation again. And it is that liquid gold under our feet that will help to do it.

“With my actions today, we will end the Green New Deal and we will revoke the electric vehicle mandate, saving our auto industry and keeping my sacred pledge to our great American autoworkers. In other words, you'll be able to buy the car of your choice. We will build automobiles in America again at a rate that nobody could have dreamt possible just a few years ago. And thank you to the auto workers of our nation for your inspiring vote of confidence. We did tremendously with their vote.

“I will immediately begin the overhaul of our trade system to protect American workers and families. Instead of taxing our citizens to enrich other countries, we will tariff and tax foreign countries to enrich our citizens. For this purpose, we are establishing the External Revenue Service to collect all tariffs, duties and

revenues. It will be massive amounts of money pouring into our treasury coming from foreign sources.

“The American Dream will soon be back and thriving like never before. To restore confidence and effectiveness to our federal government, my administration will establish the brand new Department of Government Efficiency.

Health care costs are out of control, our labor participation rate is at a 50-year low, we have no borders, jobs are leaving by the thousands, the debt

service on our national debt is nearing a point where we simply cannot pay it.

The average person hasn't had an increase in pay in 12 years. Biden's inflation has eaten up everybody's extra pennies and nickels and dimes. Over half the black men in our country are out of work. We are more divided than I can ever remember and I'm over 70 years old. We are at the brink of losing our country.
