FASCINATING FACTS OF THE BIBLE

There are sixty-six books in the Bible: thirty-nine in the Old Testament and twenty-seven in the New Testament. There are 1,199 chapters in the sixty-six books of the Bible; 31,173 verses, 773,746 words and 3,566,480 letters.

The first book in the Bible is Genesis; the last is Revelation. If you open the Bible in the middle, you will open to Psalms.

The New Testament represents 25 percent of the total Bible; the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke and John) 11.1 percent; and Psalms 5.9 percent.

The first scripture written was the Song of Deborah in Judges, Chapter 5.

The longest verse in the Bible is Esther 8:9; the shortest verse is John 11:35.

The land of Biblical times, which was about the size of Massachusetts, has many names throughout the Old and New Testaments: Canaan, the Promised Land, Israel and Judah, the divided kingdom, the united kingdom, the southern and northern kingdoms, the Hold Land, the land of milk and honey.

Jerusalem is first named in the Bible in Joshua 10:1. It is also called the Holy City, the faithful city and Zion.

2 Kings 20:11 describes how the sundial moved backward.

The word snow appears twenty-four times in the Old Testament and three times

in the New.

Scholars cannot find Cain's wife in the Bible. You can find the Christian Hymn of Love in 1 Corinthians 13; and the most-read funeral scripture in Psalm 23.

The names of Jesus' brothers appear in Mark 6:3

Ezra 7:21 contains all the letters of the alphabet except the letter j.

There are no words or names of more than six syllables in the Bible.

Animals speak in two places in the Bible: the serpent speaks to Eve in Genesis 3:1-5; and the ass speaks to Balaam in Numbers 22:28-30.

St. Jerome translated almost all of the Bible from its original Hebrew, Aramaic, or Greek into the Roman Catholic Latin translation (the Vulgate) from 382 to 405 A.D.

The first Bible printed in America was published by John Eliot in 1663 and was in an Indian language. The first American Bible printed in English was published in 1782.

The Ten Commandments are found in Exodus 20:1-17 and again in Deuteronomy 5:1-21.

The Lord's Prayer is found in Matthew 6:9-13 and again in Luke 11:2-4.

The Sermon on the Mount (Beatitudes) is found in Matthew 5:3-12.

The Golden Rule is found in Matthew 7:12.
