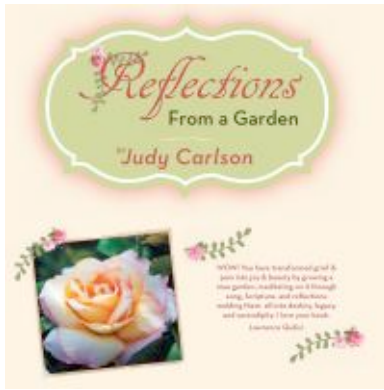

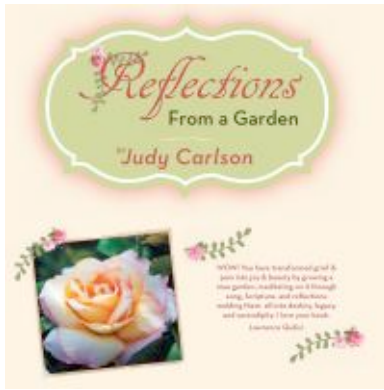
And let the beauty of the Lord our God be upon us,
