

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Chapter II

The Art of Creating

Most people do understand that they must get up off their tush, and physically do some work, if they want to get something accomplished here. What they don't realize, is that absolutely nothing gets done unless somebody indeed does it. This goes for everything, including the creation of stars and galaxies, the turning of the Earth, and the falling of rain.

Without a prime mover, the law of cause and effect is nullified. Naturally, these things are way above the levels of causation and actualization, that a normal earth creature can understand, or has any influence upon. They also work in a mechanized and predictable fashion. But there is no doubt in the mind of a true believer, that the laws and guiding principles of nature, have been fashioned through the Supreme Will. You can substitute that definition with God, "The All," or the Eternal Consciousness, if you prefer that analogy, but the fact that there is a force that creates, is indisputable.

Before anything can come into existence the thought of it must be entertained. The first principle of Syncromysticism is that all is mind.

Everything you can see, smell, taste, or touch, has been created through the thought process. Everything that exists, has existed, or ever will exist is generated and governed by the infinite powers of the Eternal Consciousness. A materialist obviously disputes this pronouncement, but thousands of humans, have spent hundreds of years, and billions of dollars, trying to figure out just what physical matter is made up of, and they can't find a single piece. Oh sure, they have names for all types, and subcomponents of physical manifestations, but it always boils down to invisible forces and packages of energy. There is nothing inherently solid about a physical object.

If you look at a brick wall, you see an obstacle, but the physicist will assure you that 99.9 percent of that wall is empty space. The same goes for your own body, so they can find no reasonable explanation of why we can't just walk through that wall, other than the fact that we have tried it, and it doesn't work. They do understand, however, that when we collide with this barrier, it is not a collision of matter, but a collision of forces that repels us. The obvious conclusion is that the physical universe is an illusion of consequences.

This illusion is facilitated by the rapid vibration of the medium that we have come to know as matter/energy, and is apparently subject to the powers of the mind. Granted, our individual minds have only a small measure of control, but if we understand the potential uses and purpose of this medium, then we can use our ingenuity and the mechanization of consequences to our own benefit. All life forms do just this in the

creation of an organic machine that helps to enhance and direct their powers of generation.

The recognition that all things are in a state of vibration, is a fundamental principle of Syncromysticism. This is not a principle that requires any lengthy discussions for most people to understand, and knowledge of this fact is generally only useful to philosophical and scientific inquiries. The realization of this underlying principle of physical matter has led to the theoretical concept of absolute zero, and to scientific understandings of thermodynamics, and resonance.

Vibration is included in the fundamental principles of Syncromysticism because it applies universally to all generated physical objects, and provides insight into the operations of this persistent illusion. It makes it clear to all, that potential energy is contained within the physical objects that constitute the known universe.

Taking advantage of potential energy is an extremely useful tactic towards your own success in any endeavor. Anyone who has ever felt the rushing tide of water, or sailed upon the windswept sea, will understand what I'm talking about. The powers of "The All," and the functions of the universe, cannot be overcome by beings that wield an infinitesimal fraction of the Generative Principle. We can, however, work in harmony with the forces that both surround us, and bind us together, in the creation of future realities that suit our own desires.

This concept of working in conjunction with superior forces leads into another important principle of Syncromysticism, the principle of

Correspondence. This is the understanding of how the universe operates on a common conceptual theme throughout all levels of manifestation.

Even though they may be separated by chasms in the plains of existence, essential elements of physical manifestation are shared universally. We allude to this in the micro-verse description of a human being. Though it may be true that you have no idea of how your body effectively functions, there is no doubt that you are in control of all these operations, even if only subconsciously.

Materialists love to talk about enzymes, and proteins, engaged in chemical reactions and working in a mechanized fashion, when they attempt to explain the mysteries of life. They always gloss over the fact, that every organism, and all the enzymes, proteins, and divergent cellular structures in a living organism, are constructed by a single cell, from scratch.

You may have wondered how the cells in your body understand what their primary functions are, or how they perceive anything at all without sense organs. Considering that you cannot read something without knowing what the symbols used to convey a language mean. How is it possible that a single cell can decipher an informational system, and implement a transformation of its own physical existence, without access to the powers of the mind? It can even unleash abilities totally alien to its own species through the introduction of foreign DNA.

In fact, the ability to develop independently into the specific types of cells that are required to construct and operate a human body, rules out

the theory of mechanized chemical reaction. You cannot argue that the act of reproduction is the result of unintended circumstances and the proximity of chemical compounds, because organic cells are not just replicating themselves, they are clearly varying their design.

Although the DNA in the nucleus of the cells is identical, and indeed the zygote at first divides into exact replications of its original composition. Ultimately, each individual cell must embark on its own unique course of action. How is any cell supposed to realize what course of generation it must follow, without access to the feedback of perspective? Do you know what a single cell perceives as its own self image? We of course view it as a little sphere of chemical compounds, and the materialist doesn't believe a single cell possesses the powers of the mind at all, but again, if it didn't, how could it understand the information contained within the DNA, and generate anything at all?

The principle of Correspondence is the component that puts the synchronicity in the mysticism. The mystical part being the powers of the mind. Without the principle of Correspondence, it would not be possible for all conscious beings to have access to the universal mind. Synchronicity is manifested throughout all the plains of conscious existence. The implementation of this structural necessity, enables the omnipotence of "The All" over the generation of the Cosmos. Like "The All," you are essentially the deity of your own micro-universe.

The mystic understands that the universe is a thought experiment. As a human being you find yourself on a very high plain of conscious

awareness. Just how high up we are, there is no way of knowing, because the levels of consciousness are truly infinite. We are aware enough to inquire into the generation of the cosmos, and to apply the forces of nature in the development and command of technology, so there is no doubt that we are at an advanced stage.

We now possess the ability to overcome the natural obstacles of our ascendancy to the supreme position in the determination of planetary consequences. In other words, we can now take control of the physical manifestation of reality, through a point of view that originates inside the phenomena. This can be either, extremely beneficial, or extremely dangerous, to the continuation of our existence.

The powers of the mind, and the forces of nature originate externally of the physical world, and so are not beholden to such a limited perspective. When the Christian Messiah stated that none are without sin, He was speaking about the contamination of the mind that occurs through its union with a physical incarnation. Exercising dominance over the manifestations of future realities by obviously limited intelligence, can only compare to having complete control of your own dream.

We all have dreams, not the desires and wants of this world, but the ones that we have in our sleep. Sometimes the ability to discern if what is taking place is really happening, or is taking place only in our own mind, can be tough to do. I normally don't remember my dreams, but there are plenty of times that I do. When you dream, do you have any conscious measure of control over what is being generated for you to

see? How do you see something with your eyes closed and your face jammed in a pillow, anyway?

In the dreams that I remember, I often question what they mean, or if they mean anything at all. This is quite an ancient and widespread human behavior, so I don't give it too much thought. Instead I seem to fixate upon why I couldn't do the things that I wanted to do, at the time that the opportunities to do them, arose in the dream. Is that odd? Perhaps you have experienced these thoughts as well.

Here in the physical universe we exist as human beings fully aware of the operating forces that govern the known universe. With this knowledge, and with the tools that we possess, we are in position to accomplish anything. Though not exactly everything is possible, technically, anything is possible. You just need to broaden the scope and theme of the concept.

I will go on the record right now, and state that it is not possible to undo what has already been done. Nor is it possible to progress to a specific point without undergoing the actions of causation. Thus, the idea of "time travelling" is specifically untenable. You can, however, learn from experience and determine the resulting outcome of reality. You may also make amends, and so even though the reality of what has previously occurred cannot be removed from actuality, the situation can often be rectified, and that's what really counts.

The Generative Principle is what allows us to carry on this thought experiment. Just like the treading of rushing water, however, or the

navigation of space and seas, we cannot use its power to overcome the principles of Correspondence, or the will of universal consciousness. It must be used with an understanding of the laws of cause and effect, and will manifest as a physical reality that cannot be undone. Yes, the brutal master we humans call time is a major component of the Generative Principle. It is the prime indicator of the unfolding of reality through the mechanism and principle of “Cause and Effect.”

By using the motions of physical properties as a measuring device, we are capable of, revealing the past, and anticipating the future. For us everything that manifests, does so now. We are always living in the now. We can envision the future, and remember the past, but you are experiencing something that is happening right now.

To generate the future that you want to experience, you must understand what is currently happening. If you falsely believe that something is occurring that really isn't, or vice versa, then your efforts to generate a desired outcome to the situation are greatly reduced. It still may be possible, but in a world where competing visions of the future manifest as a shared reality, knowledge is power.

The human species has developed the capacity to wield extraordinary power over our planet. We can anticipate the motions of our world, and manipulate the forces of nature with technology. This power, of course, brings with it the possibilities of abuse, which is exactly what we have quickly done with it. The desire to control all aspects of the developing

world that we inhabit, is destroying the human ecosystem, along with a whole lot of other species as well.

The question to ask here is, why is this reality being generated, instead of a much happier one, that the overwhelming majority of people, all over the world, desire for themselves, their families, and their friends? Where is the peace on Earth, and the good will towards men? Well, there are only really two possible answers, and it may in fact be a combination of both. Either, the people of the world don't have the slightest idea about how to generate a reality in which we can live in peace, and without major discord, or people deliberately seek to destroy other human beings, and to exploit them for their own selfish benefit.

I happen to believe that both these things are true, and it has more than just a little bit to do with our current situation. The problem I have with this conclusion, is that the people who say they want peace and prosperity for all, far outweigh the people who are benefiting from the exploitation of humanity and the planet. This means there are billions of clueless souls walking the face of the Earth, without the slightest idea that they are primarily responsible for the problem.

I know that people do have knowledge of living with each other in a generally peaceful manner, and have previously existed harmoniously with other cultures and species. How then can they just sit back and watch only a few benefit from the absolute exploitation of so many?

Obviously, the answer is ignorance, but it's not an ignorance of facts, it's an ignorance of truth. The overwhelming majority of people are so

out of touch with what is really occurring to them, that they believe they must pay other people to live in an environment which they were born into.

I mean think about it, I'm not saying you can't exchange goods and services with other people. If you want someone to do something for you, and they say "ok, I'll do that for this," then there is no problem. The problem is, that people have come to believe, that an institution which threatens them with physical harm, if they do not turn money over to it and obey its bureaucratic dictates, is bringing peace and harmony to the community in which they reside. How can you not recognize that this is absurd?

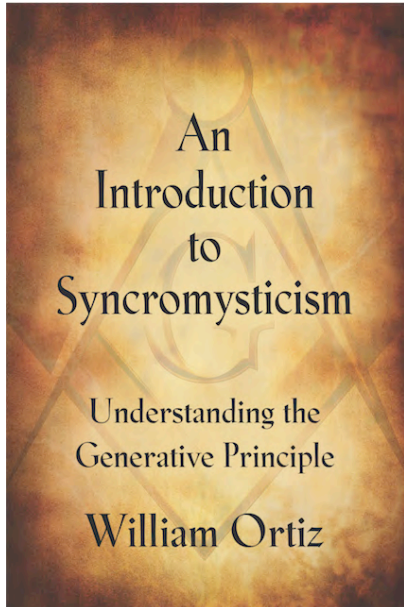
